2013 EUROPEAN ELITE TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS - REGULATIONS

1.1 The European Cycling Union will organize the 2013 Elite Track European Championships for the following disciplines. These championships may be contested by riders entered by their National Federation as a National Team.

MEN

Elite

Sprint
Keirin
Team Sprint
Team Pursuit 4 km
Omnium

WOMEN

Elite

Sprint
Keirin
Team Sprint
Team Pursuit 3 km
Omnium

Moreover, the competition programme will include the hereafter UCI Class 1 events:

- **European Women Elite Points Race**
- **European Men Elite Points Race**
- **European Elite Madison**

1.2 Entries must be submitted by National Federations on entry forms provided by the EC until the **07th of October 2013**. Entrants for European Championships shall hold licences issued by a Federation affiliated to the UEC and have the nationality of the Federation making the entry.

1.3 National Federations may nominate:

Sprint:	4 riders with a maximum of 2 riders to contest the Championship;
Keirin:	4 riders with a maximum of 2 riders to contest the Championship;
Team Sprint:	5 riders with a maximum of 1 team per nation to contest the Championship;
Team Pursuit:	6 riders with a maximum of 1 team per nation to contest the Championship;
Omnium:	3 riders with a maximum of 1 rider to contest the Championship.
Madison:	6 riders with a maximum of 2 teams per nation to contest the "European Elite Madison".
Points Race:	4 riders with a maximum of 2 riders per nation to contest the "European Elite Points Race".

Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit the UEC Track Commission may decide to run qualification heats.

1.4 The riders to contest each Championship shall be nominated by an official of the Federation to the Commissaires before the Team Managers meeting prior to the commencement of the meeting.



- 1.5 Riders must compete in their national jersey. Riders who are current world elite champions must wear their world championship jersey in their discipline.
- 1.6 In order for an event to be considered as a European Championship at least 12 riders must start in the event. The UEC Track Commission may in special circumstances agree to reduce this requirement.
- 1.7 Unless prevented by an act of God, a rider once announced as taking the start and who fails to present, shall be liable to a fine of CHF 500,00 to CHF 5,000,00.
An injury or sickness shall be recognized as an act of God only if the rider is declared incapable of taking the start by the UCI official doctor.

2 Event Regulations

2.1 Sprint

- 2.1.1 The event will be conducted in accordance with the UCI World Championships Regulations.
- 2.1.2 The best 24 or 12 riders (to be confirmed in accordance with the number of entries) in the qualifying round shall contest the competition.

2.2 Keirin

- 2.2.1 The championship will be conducted in accordance with the World Championships Regulations. Should less than 15 riders enrol to start in the championship the UEC Track Commission may decide to proceed directly from the first round and repechages to a final.

2.3 Team Pursuit

- 2.3.1 The Championship will be conducted in accordance with the World Championships Regulations. Following the World Championship Regulations the two fastest teams in the qualifying round will contest the final for first and second place and the next two fastest teams will contest the final for third and fourth place. The remaining teams will be classified in accordance with the times recorded in the Qualifying Round.

2.4 Team Sprint

- 2.4.1 The championship will be conducted in accordance with the UCI World Championship Regulations. Following the World Championship Regulations the two fastest teams in the qualifying round will contest the final for first and second place and the next two fastest teams will contest the final for third and fourth place. The remaining teams will be classified in accordance with the times recorded in the Qualifying Round.

2.5 Omnium

- 2.5.1 The Omnium Championship will be conducted in accordance with the UCI World Championships Regulations.

- 2.5.2 The Mens Elite Omnium will consist of the following events:

- 1st race: Flying lap
- 2nd race: Points race 30 km
- 3rd race: Elimination race
- 4th race: Individual pursuit 4 km
- 5th race: Scratch race 15 km
- 6th race: Kilo TT

- 2.5.3 The Womens Elite Omnium will consist of the following events:

- 1st race: Flying lap
- 2nd race: Points race 20 km
- 3rd race: Elimination race
- 4th race: Individual pursuit 3 km



5th race: Scratch race 10 km
6th race: 500 m. TT

- 2.5.4 Where the number of entries for an event exceeds the track limit the UEC Track Commission may decide to run qualification heats (in accordance with the UCI rules).
- 2.5.5 The Individual Pursuit shall be run in accordance with the World Championship regulations with the following exceptions. Heats shall be made up in accordance with the Overall Classification prior to the individual pursuit event; 1st versus 2nd; 3rd versus 4th and so on, with the riders in the leading positions starting last. Riders will be placed in the order of the time recorded over the full distance.
- 2.5.6 Riders shall be eliminated from the main bunch every 2 laps in the Elimination Race (a special communiqué will be issued).
- 2.5.7 Points races will be run in accordance with the World Championship regulations
- 2.5.8 The Overall Classification classification for each omnium shall be established on the following basis:
- a full result shall be produced for each event.
 - a cumulative total of ranks obtained in each event shall be updated in increasing order after each event.
 - the winner shall be the rider who has obtained the lowest total of rankings.
 - in the event of a tie, the best rider shall be determined by the lowest cumulated time of the time trial events.



2. 6 European Elite Madison

The European Elite Madison shall be run in accordance with the UCI World Championship regulations.

- 2 teams from each nation may contest the event;
- distances: qualif. Heats 25 km – Final 50 km

2. 7 European Men and Women Elite Points Race

The European Men and Women Elite Points Race shall be run in accordance with the UCI World Championship regulations.

- 2 riders from each nation may contest the event;
- distances: Women Points race qualif. heats 15 km – Final 25 km
Men Points race qualif. heats 20 km – Final 40 km

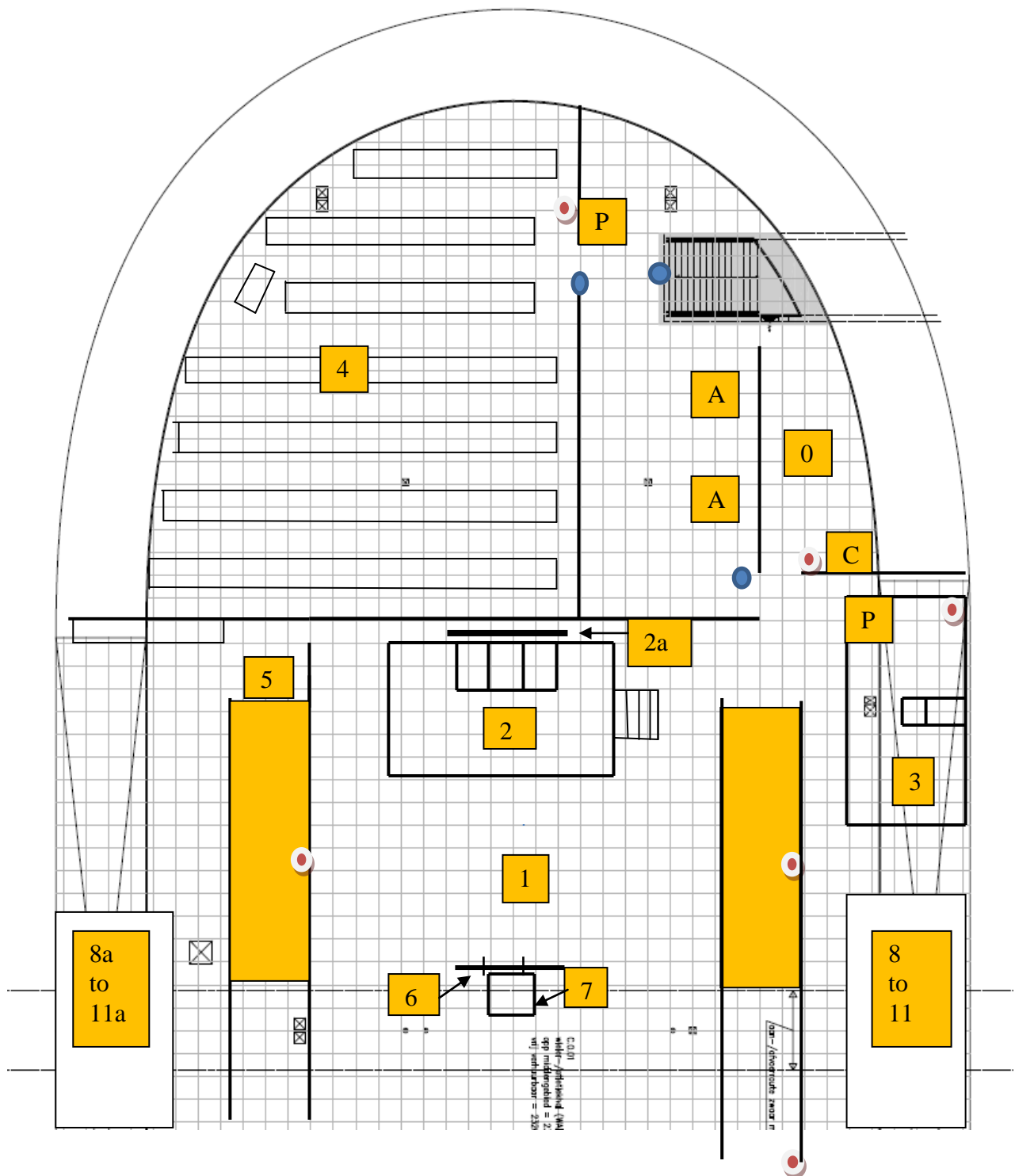

SITE MAPS / OVERZICHTSPLATTEGRONDEN



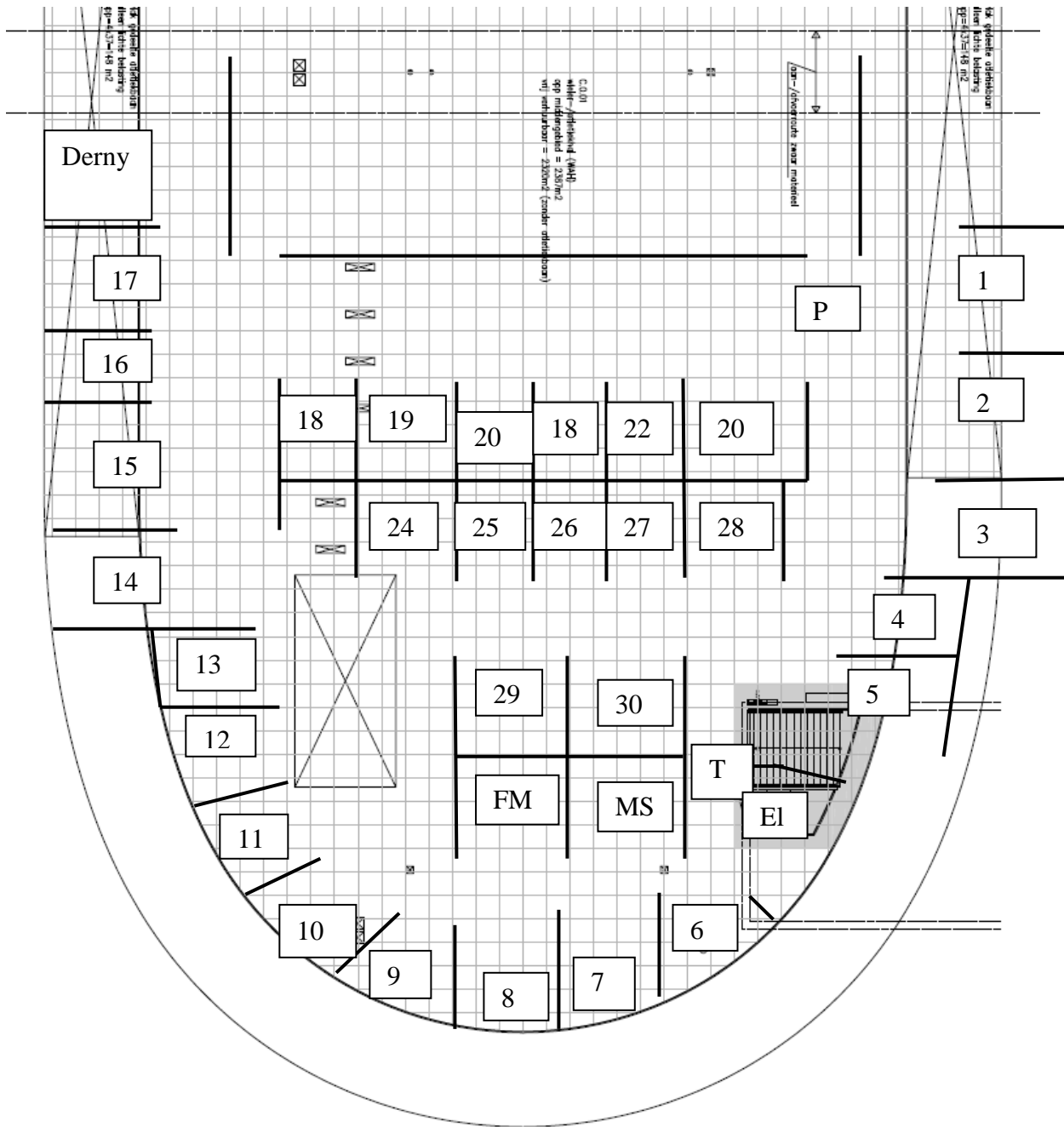

EUROPEES VOLKSLIED

In 1972 koos de Raad van Europa (die reeds de Europese vlag had ontworpen) het thema van de "Ode aan de vreugde" van Beethoven als zijn eigen volkslied en vroeg de bekende dirigent Herbert von Karajan drie arrangementen voor piano, harmonieorkest en symfonieorkest te schrijven. Dit volkslied vertolkt zonder woorden, in de universele taal van de muziek, de idealen van vrijheid, vrede en solidariteit waarvoor Europa staat.

Officieel heeft het Europees Volkslied dus geen tekst, met als belangrijkste reden dat er geen officiële eenheidstaal is in de Europese Unie, en er dus tekst in alle officiële Europese talen zou verzonnen moeten worden. Beethoven heeft z'n 9e symfonie echter wel gebaseerd op Ode an die Freude van Friedrich Schiller, waardoor deze tekst vaak gebruikt wordt als het Europees volkslied gezongen wordt.

In 2004 stelde de Oostenrijkse componist Peter Roland een Latijnse tekst voor die zou kunnen dienen als officiële tekst voor het volkslied.
